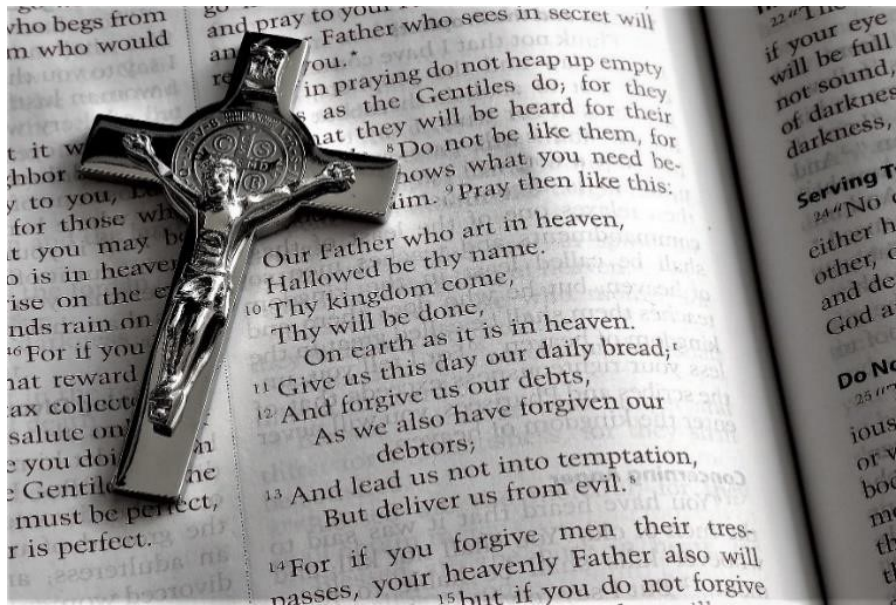
What The Bible Says About Prayer

Prayer has a prominent place in The Bible. There are over 250 references to Prayer in The Bible of which 79 appear in the New Testament. Indeed, Jesus even taught His Apostles how to pray, giving us the most beloved Prayer of all ... The Lord's Prayer. What follows is a selection of Bible Verses about Pray and Praying. Read them all ... *and Pray Today!*

Matthew 6:9-13 The Lord's Prayer ...

This is how you are to pray:

**Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,
your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth
as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread; and
forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors;
and do not subject us to the final test, but deliver
us from the evil one. Amen**



Matthew 7:7

**The Answer to Prayers. "Ask and it will be given to you;
seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened
to you.**

Matthew 21:22

**Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will

Confession and Intercession. Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The fervent prayer of a righteous person is very powerful.



The Different Purposes Of Prayer

Many of us, when called to Pray, simple read or recite from memory, one of the Common Christian Prayers such as The Lord's Prayer. Often we Pray to ask God for a special Blessing or Favor. But Prayer should not be only about asking God for favors. There are many Purposes of Prayer. We Pray to Thank God, because we feel the need to be closer to God, or because we want to establish a Spiritual Communion with God. We should all remember in our Daily Prayers to Thank God and strive to become closer to Him.

Oft times people's prayers focus only on requests, a need to be fulfilled or a favor or blessing they want. We should spend more time Praising God. He has truly worked Miracles and we should Praise Him. Just think of the last time you watched a sunrise or sunset ... God's Hand at work. God deserves our Praise more often than we give it. And God deserves our Thanks for the many Blessings we may not even realize we have. If you can't find a reason to Thank God, spend some time reflecting on your life until you can.

In this Chapter we will explore the many different Purposes of Prayer. Many of the Common Christian Prayers can fulfill multiple purposes. For example; the Lord's Prayer and the Hail Mary can be Prayers of Praise while asking for a Blessing. Below is a list of some of the many Purposes we Pray ...

- 1. Thanksgiving – we should Thank God daily for our Blessings**
- 2. Petition – asking God for a Favor or Blessing, or a Miracle**
- 3. Guidance – when you are lost and need God’s help in finding your way**
- 4. Repentance and Forgiveness – asking God’s forgiveness for our many Sins**
- 5. Prayers as a Gift – pray for your Friends, Family and Loved Ones in need**
- 6. Prayer during Crisis – in times of crisis, Prayer can have a very calming effect**
- 7. Worship Prayer – when we use Prayers to Praise & Glorify God**
- 8. Dedication – when we profess our promise to follow the Lord’s Will**
- 9. Intercession – when we ask for Saints to intercede with God for us ... *We don’t pray “to” the Saints ... we ask them to Pray “with us” to God***
- 10. Agreement – letting God know you Agree and will follow His Path for you**
- 11. Help from the Holy Spirit – when over-whelmed and you need help from the Spirit**
- 12. Prayer for Vocations – Prayer for more to answer the Calling of the Priesthood**
- 13. Impromptu Prayer – you own Pray that you make up from the Heart as you Pray**

Sometimes Prayers are prayed in a group, in a specific sequence or “string”, such as The Rosary and Chaplets to various saints. One of the most popular Chaplets is the Chaplet of Divine Mercy typically prayed at 3pm daily. If you have access to the EWTN Channel in your area, they televise it daily at 3pm EST, along with Rosaries at various times.

Another type of Prayer is a Novena, a specific set of prayers prayed every day for a set number of days, usually nine, for a specific intent. One of the more popular Novenas is to St. Jude, the patron Saint of Lost Causes. Many people in grave personal situations or with serious illnesses, like cancer, will Pray a Novena to St. Jude. A very powerful Novena.

And when you Pray Today don’t forget to also Pray for your Friends and Loved Ones. Try having a Prayer Hour with your Family. Many of us gather with Friends and Family to was an important TV Show, Football Game, or Sports Event ... why not try having a Prayer Gathering with Family built around a TV or Online Rosary or The Chaplet of Divine Mercy? The Power of Prayer is multiplied when The Faithful gather and Pray Together. So get together and Pray Today! God Bless.

Preface to Prayers For Today's Times

ESTIMATES INDICATE THAT THERE MAY BE THOUSANDS OF WOMEN AND GIRLS INVOLVED IN SEX TRAFFICKING IN THE US, WHILE WORLDWIDE THAT NUMBER IS A STUNNING 4 MILLION. AND THAT DOESN'T INCLUDE THOSE HELD AS POLITICAL PRISONERS OR FORCED TO WORK FOR LITTLE OR NO WAGES. THIS PRAYER IS FOR ALL THOSE WHO ARE UNJUSTLY IMPRISONED.

Man only dreams that slavery and bondage have been done away with. Whether bound in servitude and submission, or as a slave to outdated customs, or incarcerated by the just or unjust laws of the land, my freedom is forfeit, my hopes are dashed, and my days spent in despair. You'd be amazed the conversations that will result ... and who knows how many people that see your Display of Faith may be moved to rekindle their own beliefs and return to The Flock.**

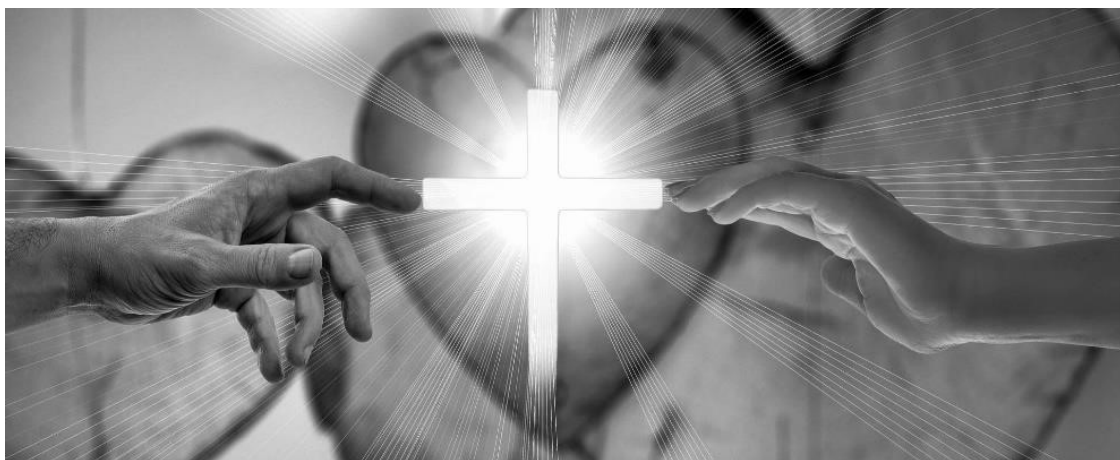

Luke 2:1-7. The Birth of Jesus

1 In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be enrolled. **2** This was the first enrollment, when Quirin'i-us was governor of Syria. **3** And all went to be enrolled, each to his own city. **4** And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the city of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, **5** to be enrolled with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. **6** And while they were there, the time came for her to be delivered. **7** And she gave birth to her first-born son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths, and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

Luke 2:8-14. The Shepherds and the Angels

8 And in that region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. **9** And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with fear. **10** And the angel said to them, "Be not afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of a great joy which will come to all the people; **11** for to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. **12** And this will be a sign for you: you will find a babe wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger." **13** And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, **14** "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among men with whom he is pleased!"

Luke 2: 46-47. Jesus Teaches In The Temple

46 After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions; **47** and all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers.

Matthew 4:12-14 & 17. Jesus Begins His Ministry in Galilee

12 Now when he heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew into Galilee; **13** leaving Nazareth he went and dwelt in Caper'na-um by the sea. **14** that what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: **17** From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Mark 3:13-19. Jesus Appoints the Twelve

13 And he went up into the hills, and called to him those whom he desired; and they came to him. **14** And he appointed twelve, [\[a\]](#) to be with him, and to be sent out to preach **15** and have authority to cast out demons: **16** Simon whom he surnamed Peter; **17** James the son of Zeb'edee and John the brother of James, whom he surnamed Bo-aner'ges, that is sons of thunder; **18** Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, Simon the Cananaean, **19** and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed him.

Mark 8: 4-9. The Fishes And The Loaves

4 And his disciples answered him, "How can one feed these men with bread here in the desert?" **5** And he asked them, "How many loaves have you?" They said, "Seven." **6** And he

commanded the crowd to sit down on the ground; and he took the seven loaves, and having given thanks he broke them and gave them to his disciples to set before the people; and they set them before the crowd. **7** And they had a few small fish; and having blessed them, he commanded that these also should be set before them. **8** And they ate, and were satisfied; and they took up the broken pieces left over, seven baskets full. **9** And there were about four thousand people.

Matthew 16:13-20 Peter's Declaration about Jesus

13 Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesare'a Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do men say that the Son of man is?" **14** And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, others say Eli'jah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." [b] **15** He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" **16** Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." [c] **17** And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jona! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. **18** And I tell you, you are Peter, [d] and on this rock [e] I will build my church, and the powers of death [f] shall not prevail against it. [g] **19** I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, [h] and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." **20** Then he strictly charged the disciples to tell no one that he was the Christ.

Matthew 14:22-24. The Institution of the Lord's Supper

22 And as they were eating, he took bread, and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to them, and said, "Take; this is my body." **23** And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks

he gave it to them, and they all drank of it. **24** And he said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many."

Mark 15: 22-27 & 37-39. The Crucifixion

22 And they brought him to the place called Gol'gotha (which means the place of a skull). **23** And they offered him wine mingled with myrrh; but he did not take it. **24** And they crucified him, and divided his garments among them, casting lots for them, to decide what each should take. **25** And it was the third hour, when they crucified him. **26** And the inscription of the charge against him read, "The King of the Jews." **27** And with him they crucified two robbers, one on his right and one on his left ... **37** And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed his last. **38** And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. **39** And when the centurion, who stood facing him, saw that he thus[[d](#)] breathed his last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"

Matthew 28:1-10 The Resurrection of Jesus

1 Now after the sabbath, toward the dawn of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the sepulchre. **2** And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone, and sat upon it. **3** His appearance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow. **4** And for fear of him the guards trembled and became like dead men. **5** But the angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. **6** He is not here; for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he[[b](#)] lay. **7** Then go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the

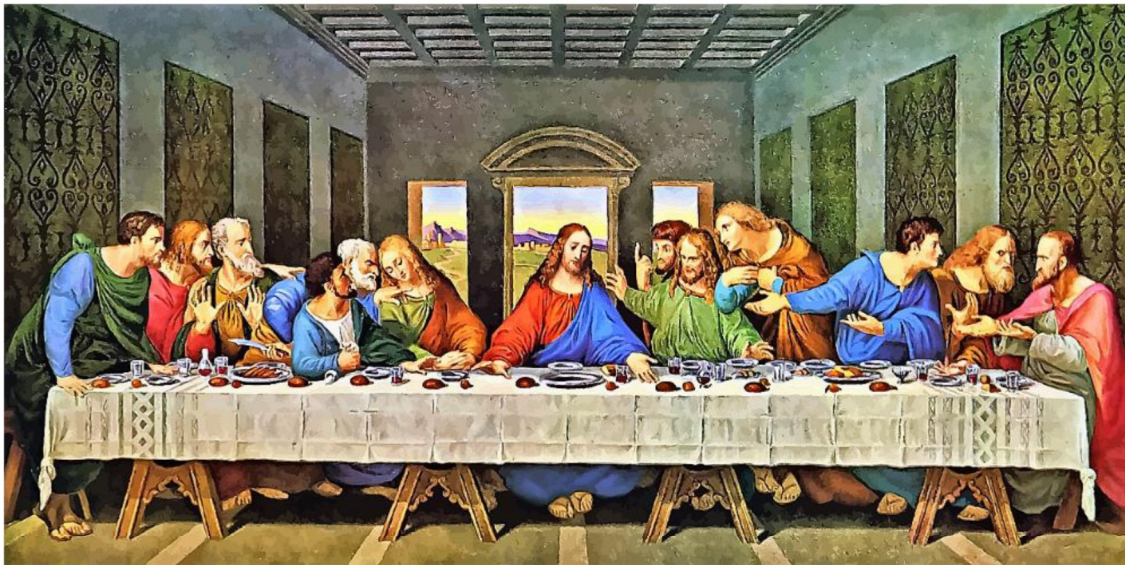
dead, and behold, he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him. Lo, I have told you.” **8** So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his disciples. **9** And behold, Jesus met them and said, “Hail!” And they came up and took hold of his feet and worshiped him. **10** Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid; go and tell my brethren to go to Galilee, and there they will see me.”

John 20: 19-23. Jesus Appears to the Disciples

19 On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, “Peace be with you.” **20** When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. **21** Jesus said to them again, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I send you.” **22** And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. **23** If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.”

Mark 16:14-16. Jesus Commissions the Disciples

14 Afterward he appeared to the eleven themselves as they sat at table; and he upbraided them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they had not believed those who saw him after he had risen. **15** And he said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to the whole creation. **16** He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
